

CROSS PLAINS ISD REPORTS HIGHLY QUALIFIED TEACHERS

The No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB) requires that all core subject area teachers meet highly qualified (HQ) teacher requirements. Each district is required to publicly report the percentage of teachers meeting this status. Cross Plains ISD reports that for the 2008-2009 school year that 97.8% of the core academic teachers in the district meet this federal requirement. Cross Plains ISD has a commitment to recruit, hire and retain highly qualified teachers for every classroom in the district. For those teachers who do not meet the “highly qualified “ status when hired, the district will work with the teacher and the certification entity in order to reach 100% HQ status.
